Your Role as Hostess:

You don't need to fill all 7 seats with people you know-any open seats will be offered to the "Marys" of the parish to join you. Be sure to place settings and prepare food for all 8 guests. This is a special opportunity to create a warm, welcoming space to celebrate the Advent season with familiar faces and possibly new friends from our SJV parish! Please let us know right away how many open seats you will have at your table.

A Table Details:

- Table size: 72" long x 30" wide (rectangle)
- Tablecloth/table covering suggested
 - Use a 90" x 132" tablecloth for a full floor-length drop.
 - Or a 54" x 96" or 60" x 102" tablecloth for a shorter, more informal drop.
- Decorate any way you like with:
 - Holiday decorations
 - Dishes & napkins (any kind from paper plates to your best china)
 - Flameless candles only (no open flame)
 - Optional: Small name place cards at seats

Refreshments:

- Please provide an appetizer and or dessert for your table (You may prepare it yourself or coordinate with your guests)
- There will be access to a kitchen to plug in any crock pots.

This gathering is a beautiful way to prepare our hearts and minds for the Advent season through conversation, laughter, and community.
