Reading Log/ Paper chain activity – Family Instructions

- Each Friday a reading log will be sent home with the kids where they can track how many minutes they read each day. The requirement will be based on age:
 - o K-1st grade - 10 minutes a day
 - o 2nd – 3rd grade - 15 minutes a day
 - o 4th – 8th grade - 20 minutes a day
- A parent will need to sign the log to verify the minutes read.
- Students return the log on Monday and give it to the teacher.

- In addition, students will get 1 strip of paper for every day they read their required minutes. SJV Home and School Association will use these paper strips to make a paper chain to show how much SJV reads.
- At the end of READ-A-THON – we will have an assembly Friday, April 3rd where we will join the paper chains from each class together to see how many days we read as a school. The chain will then be displayed somewhere in the school. Also the drawing will be held for the prizes.
